

2024 Study Bursary

Sasbo is a member of the Old Mutual Education Trust that promotes tertiary education by providing scholarships for members and their children, whereby selected beneficiaries will be subsidised for their complete studies.

What are the benefits? The scholarship provides funding to study full time, part time or on a distant learning basis, for first time under graduate degree/diploma (including BTech) at an accredited Higher Education Institution.

Who may apply? You may apply only if you are:

- A member of Sasbo
- A child of a member of Sasbo, under the age of 25;
- A grandchild or other child blood relation of the member and under the age of 25, and solely financially dependent on the member.

The scholarship covers:

- Registration and tuition fees;
- Prescribed books and other approved study materials;
- Accommodation and meals in a residence administered by the Higher Education Institution for students staying on a full-time basis.

Tips for completing the application form:

Please have the following documents ready to complete the application:

- South African ID/Passport of the main union member/union employee
- South African ID/Passport of the dependant (if applicable)
- Union membership number or union employee number (of main member or employee)
- If you are currently in Grade 12, your final results for Grade 11 and your mid-year results for Grade 12
- If you are studying at the post-matric level, your official matric certificate
- If you are a current university student, your latest year-end academic results and most recent mid-year results (previous academic year)

Please note:

- All ID/Passport copies must have been certified within the last 6 months
- Your ID number is NOT your union membership or union employee number (See eligibility criteria above)
- You must use the first name(s) and surname(s) that are listed on the official identification document

- You must ensure that you submit the correct ID/Passport number for the main union member, union employee, and dependant (if applicable)
- You must ensure that the results you have entered are accurate
- You must EXCLUDE your Life Orientation mark from the aggregate score
- Please enter the correct email and contact numbers for all parties. Do NOT change your contact number throughout the selection and verification process. You must be contactable via the contact details provided.
